- Limited to two submission per first author
- Accepted papers can be presented in the conference (10-12 minutes & 3 minutes Q&A), and will be published in the conference proceedings and HKIOT website
- Accepted posters will be posted in the conference venue
- Scholarship for young presenters of age 40 or below are provided for application

Scope:

- Hi-Touch & Hi-Tech in Occupational Therapy
- OT in neuro, cognitive, spinal, hand, psychiatric rehabilitation
- OT for children and elderly in the community
- OT innovations, education and private practice

Requirements:

- Both Chinese (max. 300 words) or English (max. 500 words) are accepted
- Chinese and English papers will be presented in Putonghua and English respectively.
- Author can only submit abstracts through conference website. at <http://www.hkiot.org/2018iotc/>
- Deadline of abstract submission is 15 Dec., 2017.
- Results will be announced on 15 Jan., 2018.
- First authors of accepted paper can apply scholarship for young presenters. Scholarship will be awarded in the closing ceremony upon successful presentation of the paper in person.
- Only conference PC can be used in presentation
- Conference secretariat will inform the size and dimension of the posters in later stage.

The Hong Kong Institute of Occupational Therapy (HKIOT), the Yuannan Association of Rehabilitation Medicine and the Kunming Medical University will jointly organize the 2018 International Occupational Therapy Conference in Kunming, Yuannan, People Republic of China, during the period from 29 March to 1 April, 2018. In order to promote occupational therapy in Mainland China, the HKIOT had invited different partners to organize similar Conferences in different parts of Mainland China, namely, 2005 in Qingdao, 2008 in Guangzhou, 2012 in Hong Kong and 2015 in Shenzhen. This Conference becomes an important platform for linking therapists in Mainland China with OTs in other parts of the World.

The theme of the Conference is “Hi-Touch & Hi-Tech in OT”, which is a very important topic in the development of occupational therapy.
